#### **Folk Art Museum**

In old stone – age, the artistic taste was found to take root in the primitive people living in caves. They first drew picture on the caves. They first drew picture on the walls of the caves about thirty thousand years ago. They were were of various types – the pictures of hunting, the picture of deer of the Vedic age. In the Vedic age, men were engaged in cultivation. The ivory work, bow chariot, the metal bowls-were their articles of everyday use. Folk arts like images of ancient deities, dishes of gold and silver, the ear-rings of palm leaves, shoes of peacock feathers, necklace, waist band were all prevelant in that age. In the middle ages, the toys of burnt soil, materials made of bamboos and canes tolled the death knell of folk art. The spinning wheel loom products bracelet industry were all ruined. In post independent Bengal under the impact of machines and globalisation, the folk art was completely destroyed. Nobody now thinks of folk art and folk industry. Nobody knows how this folk art will be recovered again its glory.

Folk art does not mean goods alone through their ancient shapes; they proclaim the aesthetics, the motif and myth. They contribute largely to Indian Economy. Both the folk art and its implementation in modern Literature, the literature complete and perfect, very commonplace things which are not so valued in the eyes of mankind bear the traditional glory of folk art which is handed down from generation to generation.

#### The necessity of its collection:

Folk art is a lost art. It bears the entity of national spirit of mankind and it contains the culture of the innocent primitive civilization. It is an art that becomes the sure manifestation of the tendencies and instincts of the people of that age. It bears the stamp of their existence. But the industrial revolution and globalisation have rendered them extinct. What remains behind are the relics of the former glory. The museum of the folk art is simply an endeavour for the recovery of the lost art. So, this kind of museum is a necessity for a nation. Through such endeavour the pulsation or heart beat of the past and present and even the future is heard.

#### The common characteristics of folk art:

- 5. The common people are the creators, carriers and preservers of this art.

- 8. Women play a major role in this folk art.
- 9. The basic foundation of human civilisation lies in folk art.
- 10. Soil, wood, stone, leaves the relics of animals and birds etc. constitute this art.
- 11. Rural people are simple, spontaneous and unreserved and their art properly correspond to their nature.
- 12. The folk art contributed a rare specimen of artistry.





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### Urbanization and its Impact on Women's Health— A Qualitative Analysis

### Abstract :

Development has overtly ensured a massive transformation of the land-use pattern over the surface of the earth. Land-use transformation and the concomitant manifestation of urbanization with rapid building –structures, migration flows and demographic changes, population exodus, incoherent basic amenities and infrastructure poses as a major factor or determinant of health issues of women. The concomitant socio-cultural and socio-economic changes of urbanization influences the perception, treatment-seeking behaviour and also, the outcome. This paper is a qualitative investigation of the socio-cultural and socio-economic factors influencing the health conditions of women.

Key words: Development, urbanization, health-issues and women.


Development dynamics has gained its acceleration in the 21st Century. Development, as a notion is a process directed towards bringing social, cultural, political, economic changes in the society, aimed at achieving certain preconceived goals for social well-being. Any forms of development aims at attaining holistic social well-being, for which transformation is inevitable and an integral part. Transformation with its myriad manifestations has made its presence felt in every sphere of societal change in the recent years. Transformations make coping with the development dynamics easier. The changing societal scenario invariably involves changing land-use pattern whereby there is a decrease in the reliance in agricultural sector and, an increased dependency on the tertiary sectors of economy. The changing land-use pattern is associated with urbanization, urbanism and urban. Urbanization and the eminent flows of migration are the resultant of development dynamics. Urbanization like development is a continuous process, once it get started. It leads to the increase in the number of cities and urban population, and, is accompanied with its unique set of advantages and disadvantages. The demographic transition, together with economic growth and industrialization has profound changes in social organization. Socio—economic transitions has an immense bearing on the health of women. The present paper attempts to understand how urbanization and the associated haphazard growth of cities and towns, and flows of migration affect the well-being of the women, especially, their health conditions.

### Concept of Urbanization as a Social Phenomenon

Urbanization is often referred to as the prime dimension of socio—economic development, and its impact is different for both the developed and developing countries (Md. Anisujjaman 2015). According to the projections of the United Nations Population Division, by 2030 an increased number of population of the developing world will be living in urban areas; and by 2050 two-thirds of the population will be urban. In the Indian context, merely 28% of the population lives in cities and it is likely to increase to 41% by the year 2020 (UN World Urbanization Prospects 2008). The process of urbanization, which is growing at a faster rate than the rural growth over the last 100 years according to the 2011 Census is often associated with transformations which have brought greater mobility, lower fertility, longer life expectancy and ageing population. Increased mobility and migration has been influenced by shift from agriculture to industry and tertiary activities, better opportunities and progress of education, improved transport and communication and modernization of norms and values. But this transformation, from the rural to urban sector and its ultimate absorption is not devoid of any stress in the receiving areas which

Drought Prone Area Programme (DPAP) was the earliest attempt of area development programme, launched by the Govt. of India during 1973-74 to minimize the problems faced by those fragile areas, which are persistently affected by severe drought conditions. The basic problems of the drought-prone areas are continuous depletion of forest cover, increasing soil erosion and immersion of groundwater level etc. Nowadays, watershed development has become the main intervention for natural resource management. Watershed development programmes not only protect and conserve the environment but also contribute to livelihood security in drought-prone areas. The importance of watershed development as a conservation programme is being recognized, essential for rain-fed areas. Watershed development activities have considerable merit on environmental, economic, ecological and socioeconomic conditions for those people who engaged in it. It is a very important consideration that the success of the watershed development programme is highly desirable because a huge amount of financial assistance is engaged behind it. The study is based on primary as well as secondary sources of data collected from beneficiary households of scheduled tribes on selected watersheds in Bankura district. The main objective of the study is to sum-up, the watershed development programme in drought-prone areas has resulted in increased crop production, productivity, employment generation, farm income and groundwater status, leading to overall rural prosperity in the study area.

#### Introduction

Water resource management is an essentials component of sustainable development as economic development is accompanied in water use. Proper watershed management leads to a triple benefit to human beings. Firstly it maintains the productive capacity of natural resources in the watershed area. Secondly, it apprehends the degradation process, and thirdly it is more cost-effective than the rehabilitation of degraded watershed. The ultimate purpose of development of watershed is to increase the economic and social well-being.

## Department of English

In the pre-Corona period, the department would make maximum use of ICT enabled tools in the classrooms. All the three classrooms of the departments are equipped with projectors, computers and other audio-visual aids. One classroom is equipped with interactive device. The department has four computers in total. - The department also helped the software vendor of the college admission software in integrating the data with the SOUL library system for issuing books to students through a single card.

#### Introduction

There has been a long demand from the teachers of Bhatter College, Dantan along with the NSS volunteers to extend their outreach programmes outside of the college premises and to adopt a few nearby Shishu Shiksha Kendra (SSK). This had taken place on date 20.09.2022 under the initiative titled "Anchol Project" by the Teachers' Council of Bhatter College, Dantan along with the NSS units of the institution. This project primarily aims at the adoption of schools for nurturing and developing the creative talents of the students. A total number of four schools have been adopted where the teachers have not only initiated fun libraries for the children but also provided many necessary teaching-learning materials like globes, maps, letters and so on for igniting their creative potential. These items would certainly provide them easy access to learning by playing and fun reading. The children were certainly very much motivated and excited to see these exchanges of experience. The teachers, caretakers and other stakeholders too were motivated to work together on a collaborative basis in near future.

#### <mark>Activities undertaken</mark>

As per the directions of the concerned Authority, the Teachers' Council and NSS Units, Bhatter College, Dantan undertook a "SchoolAdoption Programme", in which it was decided to adopt four schools within thelocality of Dantan-I Constituency. The Faculties of the Bhatter College, Dantan visitedthe nearbyschools of the Bhatter College. After analysing the student-teacher ratio, literacy rate, Financial conditions of the people, backward classes (SC & ST students), the college has adopted four schools namely

1. Sarasanka Shishu Shiksha Kendra (SSK)

- 2. Purbo Chaulia Shishu Shiksha Kendra (SSK)
- 3. Patbandha Shishu Shiksha Kendra (SSK)
- 4. Kazi Mahalla Shishu Shiksha Kendra (SSK)

The teachers of theschool were delighted with the proposal and they were quite happy with the SchoolAdoption Programme of the College. The Teachers' Council and NSS Units, Bhatter College, Dantan finally materialize the "Anchol project" on 22th September, 2022. Mr. Bikram Chandra Pradhan, honourable president of college, and Dr. P.K. Mishra, Principalinaugurated theopening ceremony of the "Anchol project" in adopted schools. The students details of the schools are as follows:

Most of the children were aged between 4 to 9 years (Class-1 to 4). In the opening day of the project all students are present in these schools. The college donated one open kids almirah with about 45 books and few teaching and learning materils to each adopted schools. The teaching and learning materils contain reference books, story books, drawing books, diierent types of Indian and West Bengal maps, chart, globe, playing alphabets and other stationary items.

Since the start of the project our NSS volunteers and students are regularly (two days a week) taking classes to these schools. Further they organize different types of cultural activities like singing, dancing, yoga etc. to motivate the students.
